We look forward to John starting with us the week of January 15th!

John Winings brings a variety of both industry and church experience to First Presbyterian Church. He served in sales/marketing, technology licensing, and manufacturing capacities before coming to North Carolina in 1990 to

work as a change executive in a variety of venture-backed firms. He comes to us from First Presbyterian Church of Wilson, having guided them through the process of securing an installed pastor. Prior to that he assisted in similar transitions at FPC Goldsboro and Mount Olive Presbyterian Churches. Now in his 11th year in pastoral ministry, pastored Butner Presbyterian Church and started what became Discovery Church in Archer Lodge.

John and his wife Debbie live in Wake Forest where they were charter members of Wake Forest Presbyterian Church. They currently are members at White Memorial in Raleigh. They have three grown children, five grand-children, two great-grandchildren and are overjoyed to be raising eleven-year-old granddaughter, Emma! Following his call to Clayton, John was called as director of a New Hope Presbytery validated ministry in Haiti called CODEP, an environmental reclamation/reforestation project in Haiti. Debbie and he lived there for five years following the earthquake, learned the language, and he later wrote a three-volume history of the project. Also during this time he served as Interim Executive, Stated Clerk, and Treasurer of the Synod of the Mid-Atlantic, PCUSA. A certified coach in the International Coaching Federation, John is active serving the presbytery, currently as co-chair of the Commission on Ministry.




